Bridge the Academic and research world with the community and those who are doing work in the community

Expand their role in the community

Population health and then work on other areas.

For Sussex County and Kent County they consider the Sussex Health Coalition. They will be putting in a grant that would like to partner with SCHC to be the community partner liaison around decision making around COVID testing.

The Proposal is to test for the antibodies every 4 months for a group of people or communities and why this is so important.

There will be a 20-minute survey that will give major demographics for the target populations. This survey will not only ask about location, but it will ask a series of questions that helps us determine why the virus is still active in that population. The communities that are ranking in fairing poorest in health disparities, large contractions of poverty and under resources communities. These communities will be the ones that rank the highest in disparities in Kent and Sussex County.

What we would like to do create with DSU is to form a relationship with our partners and connect the research, health centers, private physicians, and the state holders that address poverty and create a collective model that will improve the systems in place currently.

They will collect the data and then they will bring it back to the community partners to roll out the new plan or interpretations of it as well as.
