- Focus around what has been going on in Sussex county
 - Popup testing site at Del-Tech Georgetown 11am-3pm 4/22/2020
 - Swab site, not immediate testing
 - Christiana Care will have their van
 - Will receive additional information and literature
 - All ages, open to anyone
- The state has been working with the poultry plants
 - testing will begin on-site/universal rapid testing
 - 10% of employees are contractors – check-in around coverage for all employees
 - Will also include antibody testing
 - Rapid test includes current and antibody
- If people cannot self-isolate, hotels/motels will be open
- FSCAA – will be conducting community testing next week there as well

- Set up an overflow from Christiana – well patients help DE and the community to alleviate potential hospital demands
- Reaching out to the community around remote activities they can provide their employees to assist
 - They have already worked with Catholic Charities and YMCA
