- Unite DE from Beebe will be going live in May, Kim Blanch is working with Ebony Brown (community engagement manager)
 - SCHC TO CONNECT WITH KIM BLANCH ABOUT THIS
 - Bhavana has a contact with La Colectiva and will connect us !!!!!!!
- Wendy Bailey from DPH Diabetes and Heart Self Management has launched Healthy Heart Blood Pressure self monitoring program; no fees attached if you qualify they will provide an at home blood pressure cuff, 4 months with a health coach, cooking classes, and nutritional information; pilot or 40 patients from now until June 29, in July they are looking for ambassadors as coaches for the healthy heart ambassadors program
- Liz Phillips, Alzheimer's Association
 - ½ day Dementia Caregivers Symposium: Balancing Health & Wellness featuring 5 important topics on brain health. Flyer was sent out earlier this month
 - Association is partnering with CHEER on May 5th on forum to talk about impact of dementia and alzheimers in the community and how Sussex County can respond to gap needs SCHC WILL WANT TO HAVE SOMEONE THERE, will provide a recording after and a pre and post survey to look at addressing issues
 - Spanish speaking forum at latino community center in Wilmington
- Christina Andrews is currently accepting doula candidates
 - PICofdel.org , program is a part of healthy women healthy babies initiatives
 - Currently recruiting first cohort, first round of interviews are tomorrow, 8 training modules and 4 certifications
 - Working with New Castle County black mothers in power to work towards Medicaid reimbursement for doulas
 - 5 other states have Medicaid reimbursement including NJ which is the model we are working off of
 - Developmental milestones working with PTI in MD to do Summit for Latino and Haitian families in Western Sussex area that will focus on early learning, growth, developmental milestones in September, they are in planning process right now
