Holiday gifts can encourage problematic behavior in kids; allowing early access to potentially addictive substances puts a child at greater risk of developing a problem.

Most adults consider gambling to be “harmless” fun, so they encourage underage participation by giving gambling-themed gifts.

Like substance addictions, the earlier a child gambles, the more likely it is that they will develop a problem with gambling later.

Many adults buy video games as gifts based on what the child has requested, without looking at whether the game is age appropriate.

Current research indicates there is a link between video gaming and gambling disorder.
